In Year 3 we also learn about French Christmas traditions and make our own Christmas cards, writing the greeting in French.






We also make spinning wheels showcasing our learning of animals and fruits.

We make mini grammar books showcasing our learning on school subjects, days of the week, time and expressing opinions.

Year 6 study WW2 in history so in French we write a timeline of the events, using our decoding skills to translate a French powerpoint on the subject.

As part of their summer transition project last year 6 made lapbooks showcasing their language learning. They sent them to their new language teachers their secondary schools and enjoyed hearing their encouraging comments.
