

# Worship at St Nicholas School

Worship is integral to life at St Nicholas Church of England primary school.

Collective Worship takes various forms, with regular input from the children to ensure their ideas are represented. Worship is child-friendly, interactive and links to life today. Included are story sharing opportunities, Bible readings, songs, hymns, reflection, and prayer.

No matter what beliefs our children hold, a sense of spirituality is developed.

Worships follow a pattern in normal times, this is adapted for special services and visitors.

Monday: Values Lead Collective Worship.

Tuesday: Class worship.

Wednesday: Singing worship.

Thursday: Worship led by Reverend Karen or a minister from the Deanery.

Friday: Celebration Worship.

We pray our school will be a place of great discovery, adventure and creativity. May it be a place where we love to learn and learn to love.

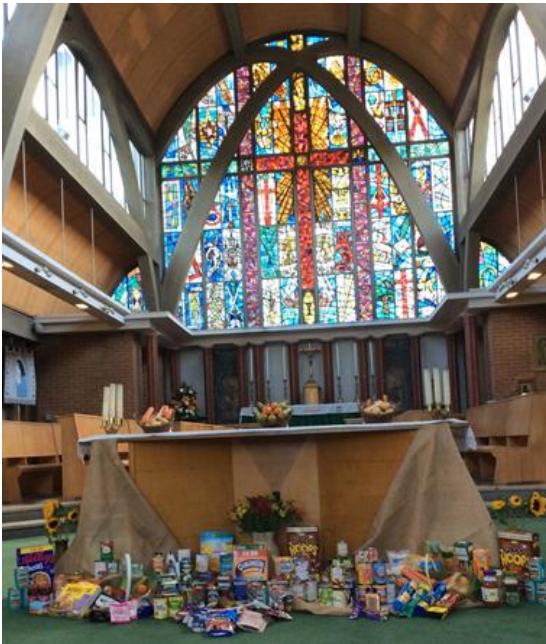
A place where everyone is respected and all are deeply valued.

In addition to worship in school we attend St Andrews and St Georges Church and also take part in community events.



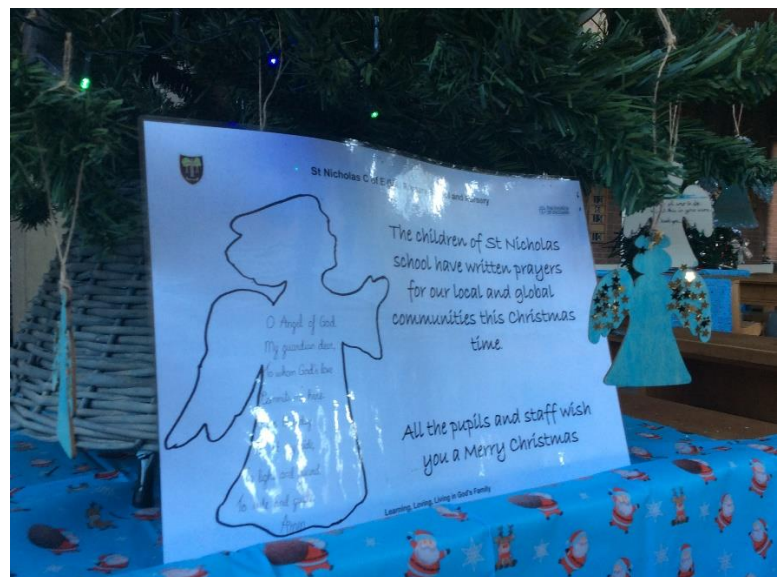

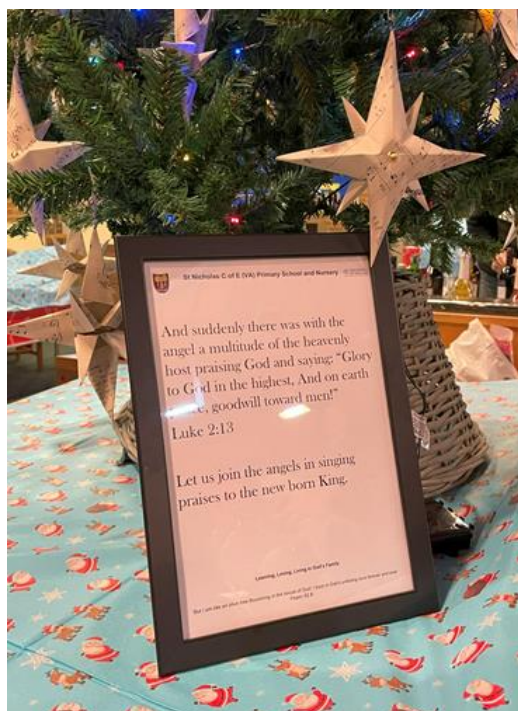


## St Andrews and St Georges Christmas Tree Festival
