Climate Justice

Year 6 are working with Christian Aid to develop pieces of Artwork linked to Climate Justice. They have investigated how Climate Change affects many global communities who do not necessarily contribute to the problem. The aim is to show MPs and visitors that the future generation has a viewpoint which should be considered.
