School Nativities and Carol Service

Nursery children are invited to stay for lunch on that day, even if they normally go home at 11:45am. They can be collected at 12:45pm on this day.

The cost is free for Reception, Year 1 and Year 2, £2.85 for Nursery and £3.45 for Years 3-6.

If your child prefers the vegetarian/vegan option, please indicate in the notes box.

Please note: There is no jacket potato option or school packed lunch option on this day.

Please be aware that your child will not be able to have a Christmas dinner unless parents have let us know via Arbor. If this is the case, you will need to provide a home packed lunch on this day.

Children can wear a **Christmas jumper** with their uniform on this day (ties not necessary). If they have PE, they should wear their PE kit as usual with a Christmas jumper if they want to wear one. **A donation to Save the Children** would be much appreciated and can be made on Arbor.
